



Tahmina's Journey from the Shadows of Victimhood to the Light of Justice

On the night of March 19, 2021, Tahmina's life took a harrowing turn when Mehboob Shah, her maternal uncle, and five others forcibly entered her home, armed with a pistol, with sinister intentions. In the aftermath of this traumatic event, Tahmina's father, Barket Shah, bravely filed an FIR on March 23, 2021, at the Kotri police station.

The investigation, led by IO SIP Sikander Ali, unfolded a tale of horror and strength. Tahmina's recovery from Mehboob Shah's custody on April 7, 2021, marked a turning point. Despite the challenges, Tahmina stood strong, providing statements under 164 CrPC and undergoing medical examinations.

On July 18, 2022, the judge, after considering multiple injuries on Tahmina's left breast and shoulder, DNA evidence matching the accused, and the support of all witnesses and medical officers, announced a landmark verdict.

The judgment declared Mehboob Shah guilty, proving the prosecution's case against him. He was sentenced to 10 years of imprisonment under Section 376 PPC and fined Rs. 50,000. If he fails to pay the fine, an additional three years of imprisonment awaits him.

This tale of triumph concludes within 16 months, a testament to the efficiency and dedication of Legal Aid Society's advocate Shahnaz Buriro and the judicial system.

Tahmina's journey, from the shadows of victimhood to the light of justice, stands as an inspiring example of the strength that can be found in the pursuit of truth and the unwavering support of those who stand up for justice.
