The dedicated lawyers filed a petition before the Sindh High Court under Section 491 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1908 and raised the plea to set the minor at liberty and her custody should be handed over to Shazia.

However, the case faced a jurisdictional challenge and was transferred from Karachi to Sukkur. Devoted and undeterred, our legal team in Sukkur took the reins, working in close collaboration with our legal team in Karachi.

This seamless cooperation ensured that Shazia's case is managed with the utmost care and professionalism with legal relief provided to her in the case.
